**RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF PUBLIC PROSECUTOR IN GROUP-A SERVICE UNDER HOME DEPARTMENT**

**THE LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATION IS THE 31<sup>ST</sup> OCTOBER, 2008 BY 5.00 P.M.**

113-D: Applications in the prescribed form are invited for admission to the Competitive Examination to be conducted by the Commission under the provisions of the Orissa State Prosecution Service Rules, 1997 for recruitment to 3 (three) posts of Public Prosecutor in Group-A Service in the pay scale of Rs. 9,350-325-14,550/- with usual Dearness Allowance and other allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Orissa from time to time. The posts are permanent.

**2. VACANCY POSITION:** All the three vacancies are unreserved. The number of vacancies to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by Government without notice depending upon the exigencies at the discretion of the Government.

**3. AGE:** A candidate shall not ordinarily be below 21 (twenty-one) years and above 45 (forty-five) years of age as on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2008. The upper age limit is relaxable by 3(three) years for candidate belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C.), by 5 (five) years for candidate, who belongs to the categories of S.C/S.T./Woman/eligible Ex-Servicemen and by 10(ten) years of P.H. candidate.

**SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE, THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.**

The date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board will be accepted by the Commission. No other document relating to age like horoscope, affidavit, birth certificate, service records and the like will be accepted,

Provided that a candidate who comes under more than one category mentioned above, shall be eligible for only one age relaxation benefit, which shall be considered most beneficial to him/her.

## **QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

A candidate must have obtained the minimum qualification of Bachelors Degree in Law from a recognized University and having continuous active practice as an Advocate at the Bar of not less than 15 (fifteen) years as on the last date fixed for the receipt of applications.

**5. HOW TO APPLY: (i) Application Form:** For details please see the detailed Advertisement, which can be obtained along with the prescribed Application Form from the Office of the Orissa Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001 personally between 11.00 A.M. & 1.30 P.M. and 2.00 P.M. & 4.00 P.M. on any working day on cash payment of Rs.30/- (Rupees thirty) only or by Registered Post on remittance of Rs.55/- (Rupees fifty-five) only by Money Order. Full name and address of the candidate and name of the Post advertised must be specified in the Money-Order Coupon in BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS.

**(ii) If Money-Order from any candidate for supply of prescribed Application Form is not received in the office of the O.P.S.C. before 10 (ten) days from the last date for receipt of applications, the same shall not be accepted and accordingly no Application Form will be supplied to such candidate by Registered Post.**

(iii) The candidates may also download the prescribed Application Form and copy of detailed Advertisement from the Website of the O.P.S.C., i.e. <http://opsc.nic.in>. The General and S.E.B.C. candidates downloading the Application Form will be required to pay Rs. 130/- (Rs.30/- for prescribed Application Form + Rs.100/- towards Examination Fee) only in shape of Indian Postal Order/Bank Draft/Pay Order/Treasury Challan, as provided under Paragraph- 10 of the detailed Advertisement at the time of submission of Application Form. The S.C. / S.T. candidates downloading the prescribed Application Form will be required to pay Rs. 30/- towards prescribed Application Fee only in shape of Indian Postal Order/Bank Draft/Pay Order/Treasury Challan as the case may be, at the time of submission of Application Form. The S.C. /S.T. candidates are, however, exempted from paying the Examination Fee.

**(iv) Last date for receipt of applications:** Candidates are required to send their applications in the prescribed form by Registered Post/Speed Post/Courier Service to the Special Secretary, Orissa Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack-753001. The Commission shall not take any responsibility if the application is not received in time. The candidates may also submit their applications in the closed covers in the Office of Orissa Public Service Commission directly/personally on or before the last date of receipt of applications at the Counter. The closed envelope containing the application must be super scribed “**Application for recruitment of Public Prosecutor**”. The candidates submitting their applications directly/personally at the Counter of Orissa Public Service Commission will be given proper acknowledgement receipt.

**(v) Applications received after the last date shall not be entertained.** However, if an application is received by Registered Post/Speed Post/Courier Service after due date, it may be accepted provided the date of posting marked on the body of the cover/envelope by the Postal Department/Courier Service indicate that it was posted at least seven days before the last date fixed for receipt of applications.

**6. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF APPLICATIONS :** Immediately on receipt of Application Form of a candidate, the Acknowledgement Card (Post Card in case of down loaded application form) submitted by him/her along with the Application Form, will be dispatched by the Commission's office to him/her. The mere fact that a candidate's application has been acknowledged does not mean that his/her candidature for the recruitment has been accepted by the Commission.
